The Ducati Racing Rewards Rules

Eligible Ducati Motorcycles:

- 1) 2007 or newer U.S. or Canadian certified.
- 2) 1098, 1098 S, 1098 R, 848, Sport 1000, Sport 1000 S, GT 1000, Hypermotard, Hypermotard S, and Monster 696.
- 3) Bike must have a valid retail registration on file with DNA prior to race date.
- 4) Ducati brand and model name logos must be visible on both left and right side fairings. In the event that the bike is equipped with aftermarket plastic, Ducati logos of at least 4 x 2 inches must appear on the left and right side of the fairing in clear view. You must provide photographs of your motorcycle with your first claim clearly showing the logo placement.
- 5) Bike must conform to all of the rules of the sanctioning body and class in which it is raced. Sanctioning body rules also have final determinations of the model eligibility for each of the classes.



Rider Requirements:

- 1) Awards will be made payable to the retail registered (VIN) owner of the motorcycles.
- 2) In the case of Championship awards, the rider must compete on a qualified Ducati motorcycle exclusively in all races that count towards the Championship.
- 3) Ducati must be listed as a sponsor on the event entry form.

Claims and Event Regulations:

- 1) Program Period - January 1st 2008 to December 31st 2008.
- 2) To claim an award, DNA must receive a Contingency Claim Form from the rider / owner after every qualifying race within 30 days after the event. Any claim received after 31 days will be denied.
- 3) Awards will be made only after the race promoter confirms race results and that the rider competed on a qualified Ducati.
- 4) Class must have at least 10 starting entries to be eligible for Contingency Rewards
- 5) Falsification of a contingency claim will result in not only disqualification of that claim, but also the disqualification from **all** future contingency programs.
- 6) Program details and qualifications are subject to change without notice.
- 7) The decisions of DNA in all matters relating to the interpretation or application of this contingency program shall be final.
- 8) DNA has the right to modify or cancel this program at anytime without notice.

Contingency Product Certificates:

- 1) Ducati Dealer Racing Reward Certificates are redeemable at any authorized Ducati Motorcycle Dealer in North America.
- 2) Product Certificates have no cash value, and may only be redeemed for genuine Ducati Spare Parts, Ducati Accessories, Ducati Apparel, and Ducati dealer labor service charges.
- 3) All Product Certificates must be redeemed at an authorized Ducati dealer no later than December 31st 2008.

Dealer Credit Process for Product Certificates:

- 1) Dealers are to complete the dealer information section of the original Product Certificate with dealership name, dealership number, redemption date, and a signature attesting that the certificate was faithfully redeemed in accordance with the stipulations of this program. DNA suggests that all dealers confirm the identification of the redeeming customer.
- 2) Dealers will submit via mail only (no faxes) the original Product Certificate and a copy of the counter invoice or repair order to which the value of the Product Certificate was fully applied. Product Certificates may only be redeemed for genuine Ducati Spare Parts, Ducati Accessories, Ducati Apparel, and Ducati dealer labor service charges.
- 3) To qualify for credit, Product Certificates must be received at DNA no later than 45 days after the date upon which the customer redeemed the Product Certificate.
- 4) Program terminates December 31st 2008 and no Product Certificates will be processed for dealer credit after that date.
- 5) Credits for Product Certificates will be posted to the dealer's parts account.
